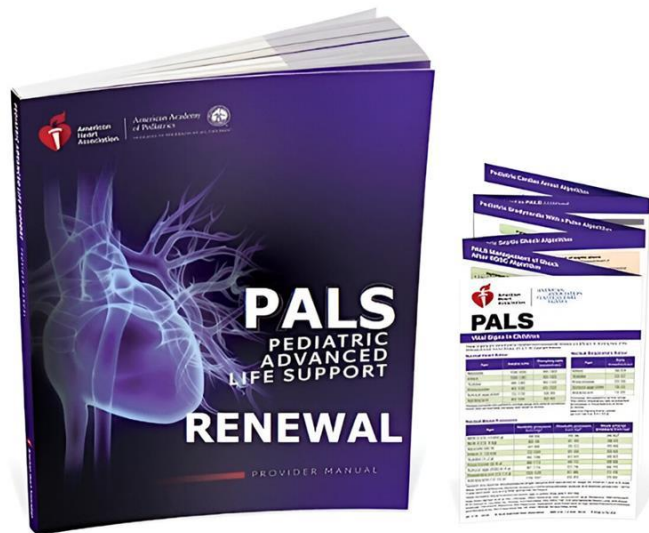

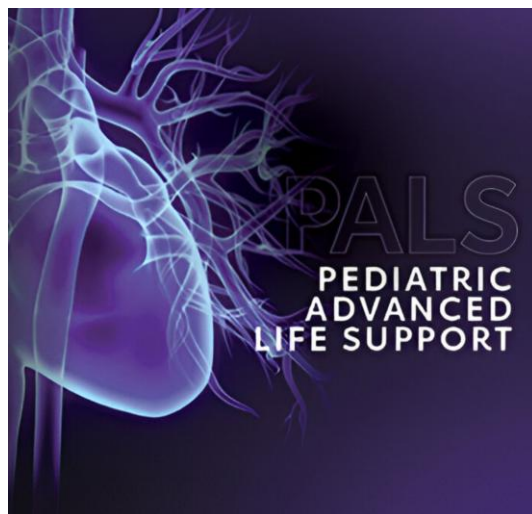

Prerequisites:

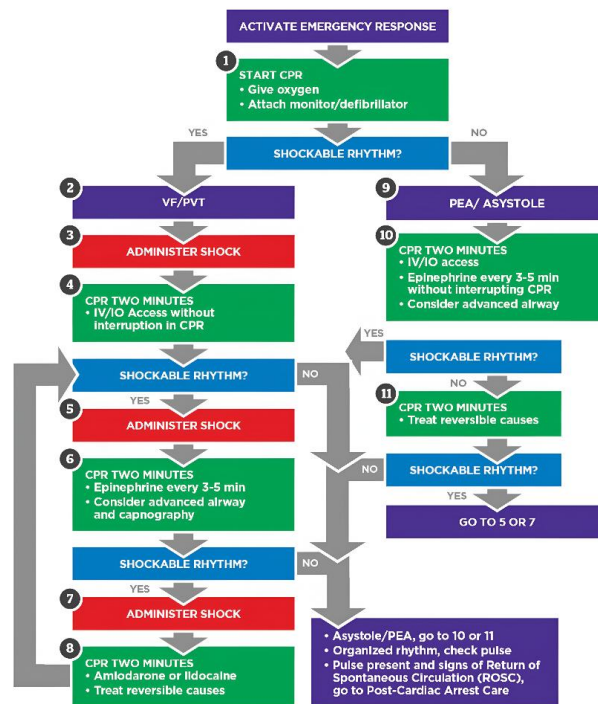
Before attending the **PALS for Healthcare Providers** course, participants must:

- Understand basic ECG rhythms and pharmacology.
- Possess or purchase the **PALS Provider Manual** before class.

For those who need to refresh their ECG interpretation skills, PDRE offers the **BART (Basic Arrhythmia Recognition and Treatment)** course as a recommended prerequisite.

Course Materials and Tools:

Students receive a **PALS Provider Manual**, which includes essential reading materials, visual guides, and checklists to prepare for both the classroom and final assessments. The **PALS Pocket Reference Card Set**, sold separately, is a valuable tool that includes algorithms for cardiac arrest, shock management, bradycardia, tachycardia, and post-resuscitation care.



Certification and Renewal:

Upon successful completion of all course requirements—including written exams, CPR and AED skills testing, and two simulated case evaluations—participants receive their official **AHA**

PALS certification card, valid for two years. Renewal courses are available for those whose certifications are expiring.

Participants must:

- Actively complete all learning stations.
- Pass the written exam with at least 84%.
- Successfully manage cardiac and respiratory/shock scenarios as team leaders.

Continuing Education and Accreditation:

The [American Heart Association PALS](#) course is accredited by the **Commission on Accreditation of Pre-Hospital Continuing Education (CAPCE)**. It offers continuing education hours (CEHs) for physicians, nurses, physician assistants, and pharmacists.
